The Office of the Lieutenant Governor continues to work diligently on your Inspection of Public Records Act request dated November 11, 2009, later clarified on November 23, 2009, for which you requested: "all contracts entered into between the Lt. Governor's office and any vendor of any nature that provided her office either a service or product between January 2003 and present" – and the supporting "invoices", "purchase orders" and "correspondence" or "any other document discussing the expenditure, invoicing or payment . . ."

To comply with this request in full, the Office will need to compile all receipts, correspondences, contracts and vendor agreements relating to even the most routine office products and services, such as paper clips, staplers and Xerox machine leases purchased over the past seven years.

If that was the intent of your request, the office will continue its work to compile those records in full. While it was our objective to respond in full within 90 days (as noted in letter dated December 1, 2009), this request continues to be excessively burdensome and broad, and will require considerably more time. If you would like to review or purchase copies of the responsive documents, which the office has compiled to date, please notify us and they will be prepared.

However, if you would like to narrow the scope of your request, the office may be able to respond in full at a sooner date. Please clarify whether you would like the language in your original request to stand, or whether you will be narrowing the scope of your request.
