According to the New Mexico Supreme Court's Disciplinary Board's Counsel, Montoya engaged in a "pattern of misconduct" including lying, deceit, dishonesty, and fraud.

But it's even worse given that Dennis Montoya's misconduct took place while he was representing an eight-year-old boy whose father had died tragically in a car accident. According to the Disciplinary Board's prosecutor, because of Montoya's actions the boy didn't receive hundreds of thousands of dollars owed to him.
