

Phil Griego statement

The nine-count Criminal Complaint and Request for Summons filed today in Santa Fe District Court contains criminal charges alleging Phil Griego used his role as a legislator to receive personal compensation, which he then failed to disclose in filings required of legislators. The Complaint also alleges Mr. Griego withheld the commission share owed to each of his qualifying brokers, acts charged as fraud. Also alleged is the fraud against the State of New Mexico for failing to disclose his interest in the deal, and for failing to alert anyone to factual inaccuracies and misstatements made at various times regarding the sale.

The filed Complaint reflects an investigation conducted by the Office of the Attorney General. A summation of the allegations is contained within the Complaint. Prosecutors will present the matter at a later date.

This matter will be submitted for a probable-cause determination. The Office of the Attorney General has no further comment on this matter beyond the Complaint.
