The purpose of this correspondence is to provide you with the determination of the Office of the Secretary of State regarding the above-referenced complaint. First, thank you for providing the information necessary for our office to consider the allegations contained within the complaint. After review of the available information, it is the determination of the Office of the Secretary of State that the allegation, as alleged within the complaint, did not constitute a violation of the law. While the Secretary requests voluntary compliance with the disclosure laws as provided in the Campaign Reporting Act, based upon a 1995 opinion of the United States Supreme Court, the New Mexico Attorney General issued an opinion letter in 1997 confirming that the disclosure statutes were unconstitutional and unenforceable. Accordingly, our office is closing your file on this matter.

Please be advised that our file regarding this matter is a public record and subject to inspection pursuant to the New Mexico Inspection of Public Records Act.
